1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that his daughter has been missing since 31st May, 2019 and although he had moved an application dated 7th June, 2019 (Annexure P-1) to the Police but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-1) expeditiously and in case, the allegations made therein are found to be well-founded then
