1. Petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.381 dated 26.05.2019 under Section 381/34 IPC registered at Police Station Mujesar, District Faridabad.

2. The allegations against the petitioner are that he was working as helper in a marriage banquet hall. He along with one Gaurav is suspected of having committed theft by stealing 80 litres of diesel which was stored in four different cans of 20 litres each capacity.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner points out that co-accused Gaurav has already been released on bail and the petitioner is willing to join the investigation for providing any information or document, as and when required by the Investigating Officer.

4. In these circumstances, the writ petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigation Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
