Petitioner Amjad has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.458 dated 01.06.2019, registered at Police Station Nuh, under Section 408 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the FIR, the present petitioner was posted as a salesman on the petrol pump of the complainant. He along with the Manager of the petrol pump embezzled the amount of ₹3,63,568/- by forging the record etc.

It is argued by learned State counsel that most of the entries in

the record were in the hand of present petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; serious allegations against the petitioner and the fact that he is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
