It has been pleaded that one Manjit Kaur and her son Sharanjit Singh are involved in FIR No.151 dated 11.06.2019 under Section 307/34 IPC registered at Police Station Jamalpur, Ludhiana (offence under Section 302 IPC added subsequently).

Petitioners herein who are 17 in number are stated to be all relatives of Manjit Kaur.

A mandamus is sought to direct the official respondents No.3 to 6 not to harass the petitioners only on account of the fact that their close relative namely Manjit Kaur is involved in the afore-noticed FIR.

Counsel submits that the police authorities are conducting repeated raids on the residential premises of the petitioners and they are being put to unnecessary harassment.

Against the backdrop of the grievance raised and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition with a direction to respondent No.2

i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into the matter against the backdrop of a representation dated 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) that is stated to have already been made and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and warranted in accordance with law.
