The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.29 dated 10.04.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 326, 506 IPC (Section 324 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar, Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the injuries which are attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature and on the non-vital parts of the body of the complainant.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 20.06.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kamal Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 20.06.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
