Prayer in this petition is for grant of pre arrest bail in FIR No.48 dated 22.05.2019 under Sections 323/324/326/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

On 20.06.2019 the following order was passed by this Court:

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version as petitioner himself was admitted in the hospital on account of as many as 8 injuries.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State of Punjab and seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 25.07.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as

provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Narinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 20.06.2019 is made absolute.
