Instant petition was filed seeking Mandamus for directing the official respondents to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 12. As per pleadings on record the petitioners herein had got married with each other on 18.6.2019 against the wishes of the family members of petitioner no.1. Both the petitioners are stated to be major.

The instant protection petition came up for preliminary hearing on 20.6.2019 and whereupon counsel for the petitioners contended that after filing of the petition, petitioners have been kidnapped from the parking area of this Court by the parents/immediate relatives of petitioner no.1. On 21.6.2019 this Court had directed the Investigating Officer to produce petitioner no.1 in Court on the adjourned date.

In compliance of the order dated 21.6.2019 petitioner no.1 Gurpreet Kaur is present in person.

I have interacted with Gurpreet Kaur in my chamber. She has categorically submitted that on 20.6.2019 she had placed a phone call to her parents and thereafter had gone away with them to her parental home of her own will and accord. She has further categorically stated that she now wishes to stay with her parents.

In view of the above, no directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is accordingly dismissed.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
