petitions i.e. CRR-3172-2018, CRR-3737-2018 and CRR-1033-2019 as the point in issue involved in all these petitions is identical.

Learned counsel for the petitioner in CRR-1033-2019 submits that since the petitioner has completed the entire sentence as awarded by the trial vide judgment dated 29.11.2014 and upheld by the Lower Appellate Court vide judgment dated 06.09.2018, all the three petitioners have been released from the District Jail, Nabha.

The counsel submits that since the petitioners have undergone the entire sentence of one year awarded by the Courts below, he do not intend to press these petitions as the same have become infructuous.

Learned State counsel has filed separate custody certificates of all the three petitioners. As per the custody certificates, petitioner-Mukhtiar Singh was released on 09.06.2019, petitioner Jatinder Singh @ Billu was released from jail on 09.06.2019 and petitioner Sandeep Singh @ Deep was released on 10.06.2019, on completion of their sentence.

In view of the same, all these three petitions are rendered infructuous and are dismissed as such.
