While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed
by this Court on 20.6.2019:-

“It is, inter alia, submitted that after issuance of notice of motion in CRM-M-13137 of 2019 filed by the present petitioners, they had approached the police authorities. However, on 07.05.2019 their counsel did not appear before this Court and their petition was dismissed as the proper facts could not be brought before the Court.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3. Copies of the petition be handed over to him during the course of the day.

Notice be issued to respondents No. 4 to 8 for 04.07.2019.

In case, the petitioners put forth any apprehension regarding their life and personal liberty before respondent No. 2– Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur within the next two days, he shall look into the matter and take appropriate action if any/as may be required.”

Learned State counsel has filed in Court today a status report by way of affidavit of Jagjit Singh, S.I., Police Station, Malerkotla on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3.

As per contents of the status report, statements of the petitioners as also the immediate/close relatives of petitioner no.1 have been recorded. As per statements given by the petitioners they do not now apprehend any threat to their life and liberty. As per statements furnished by the private respondents i.e. parents as also uncle of petitioner no.1 they are not opposed to the matrimonial alliance entered into between the petitioners.

No further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
