On 20.06.2019, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that from a bare reading of the FIR, offence under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code is not made out as there are no allegations/assertions of abatement to commit suicide as defined in Section 107 of the Indian Penal Code.Notice of motion for 01.08.2019.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the petition be handed over to Ms. Bhavna Gupta, DAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bal Raj has submitted that the petitioner in this case has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 20.06.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
