In this petition the petitioners prayer was that the structures in their occupation be not demolished.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that demolition has already taken place and possession taken.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners would be entitled to rehabilitation.

We are of the opinion that since possession has already been taken by the respondents after demolishing the structures, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, however, with liberty to the petitioners to pursue their remedies with the respondents to seek rehabilitation in terms of the existing policies or the

ones that may be formulated for the purpose. In case such demands are

raised by the petitioners upon the respondents they would look into their grievance as expeditiously as possible.
