Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.468 dated 4.6.2019 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Karnal, Civil Lines, District Karnal.

On 27.6.2019, the following order was passed :-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that in fact there is a matrimonial discord between the petitioner and his wife and the petitioner is ready to explore the possibility of some settlement. It is further submitted that out of total amount of three cheques approximately Rs.5.00 lacs, Rs. 2.00 lacs have already been returned by one of the person, in whose account, the same was transferred by way of one of the cheque referred to in the FIR. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to return the remaining amount of Rs.3.00 lacs to the respondent-complainant and is also ready to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for the purpose of exploring the possibility of some amicable settlement.

Notice of motion.”

Counsel for the petitioner submits that admittedly an amount of Rs.2.00 lacs has already been paid to the complainant and he has handed over a demand draft of Rs.3.00 lacs, which is accepted by the complainant and stands encashed.

In view of the same, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.6.2019 passed by this Court, is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
