Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.78 dated 22.04.2019 registered under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the FIR was registered against unknown persons and later on, the petitioners were nominated in the FIR. It is further submitted that even the matter has been compromised with the complainant and relies upon the compromise dated 26.05.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Counsel for the complainant acknowledge the factum of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Counsel for the State has filed the Custody Certificate today in the Court and on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position. It is further submitted that the petitioners are not involved in any other case.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the dispute of which the present petition is an off-shoot has been resolved amicably; the petitioners are not involved in any other case, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate concerned.

However, it will be open for the prosecution or the complainant to apply for cancellation of bail, in case the petitioners are found involved misusing the concession of bail.
