TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner seeks a writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the official respondents to release him on emergency parole for a period of four weeks so as to attend marriage of his brother which is to be solemnized on 23.06.2019.

Placed on record at Annexure P-5 is an order dated 08.06.2019 passed by the Superintendent District Prison, Gurugram and in terms of which a view has been taken that the petitioner is entitled to be released on temporary basis to attend the marriage of his brother under armed police escort for a period of 48 hours. However, the order further recites that if the convict/petitioner so desires to avail of such release on temporary basis for a period of 48 hours if may apply to the concern Superintendent of Jail.

Counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing today does not press the prayer for grant of emergency parole for 4 weeks but

merely voices an apprehension that even the view/decision dated 08.06.2019 (Annexure P-5) would not be implemented and the petitioner would not be released.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

A statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that in case the petitioner makes a formal application to avail of the decision contained in the order dated 08.06.2019 at Annexure P-5, during the course of the day, he would be granted the benefit of temporary release for a period of 48 hours under the armed police escort so as to attend the marriage of his brother slated for 23.06.2019.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed.

Petition disposed of.
