Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner having already remained in custody for more than 03 months and the allegations even as per the statement of the deceased (as recorded by the complainant) being that the deceased was made to fall in love with her, the petitioner deserves the concession of bail.

Though as per the FIR, an allegation has also been made that the petitioner demanded money from the deceased (to keep the affair secret), still, keeping in view the fact that she has undergone 03 months of actual imprisonment and obviously, as per the said statement, the deceased did not deny the affair, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, the petition is allowed with the petitioner to be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
