Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.50 dated 03.05.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Jhander, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that as per the allegations, son of the petitioner had fired, causing injuries to the injured-complainants Harsimrandeep Singh and Harsh Dogra. It is further submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 acknowledges that the matter stands compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Jasbir Singh, also

could not dispute the factual position that there is no direct allegation against the petitioner, as the gun shot was fired by his son namely Navikaran Singh.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and also in view of the fact that the parties have entered into a compromise, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
