Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.208 dated 15.06.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana, under Sections 307, 452, 294, 509 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is a case of version and cross-version and the petitioner has also sustained four injuries on his person.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner is named in

the FIR and stated to be armed with a spade. He has caused injury

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dangerous to life on the head of injured-Mewa Singh.

The petitioner is required for custodial interrogation and spade is still to be recovered. He being the main accused, is not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
