The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 9 dated 21.01.2019, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

The operative part of the order dated 24.06.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version. The allegation against the petitioner is that he gave kappa blow to the complainant on his right arm. The petitioner himself received injuries on his head with a spade blow from the complainant. The dispute was on account of throwing waste in front of the house of the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 16.07.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 24.06.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Taranjit

Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.06.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
