Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner Vishal Girdhar son of Lekh Raj in case F.I.R. No.153 dated 04.04.2019 under Sections 419, 420 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 406, 467, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Nagar, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2019, challan has already been presented in this case, co-accused Vipin Makhija and Surender Kumar alias Sahil, who are similarly situated, have already been released on bail as per orders of this Court dated 24.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-23292-2019 and 19.06.2019 passed in CRM-M-26814-2019 respectively. Trial of the case still to take

some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel opposed the prayer for bail and on instructions from ASI Vinod contended that the recovery was effected from the present petitioner and, as such, he does not deserve the concession of bail.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2019, co-accused, who are similarly situated, namely, Vipin Makhija and Surender Kumar alias Sahil have already been released on bail as per orders of this Court dated 24.05.2019 passed in CRM-M-23292-2019 and 19.06.2019 passed in CRM-M-26814-2019 respectively, trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Vishal Girdhar, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
