Application for disposal of the main appeal in view of the judgment dated 17.11.2017 passed by the Apex Court in **Civil Appeal No.19354 of 2017 'Rajender Singh and others v. State of Haryana and others'** has been filed, whereby market value of the land acquired has been finalized.

Accordingly, the application is allowed and main case taken on board today itself for disposal.

CM stands disposed of.

Main appeal

It is not disputed that the Apex Court in **Rajender Singh's case (supra)** while deciding bunch of cases pertaining to both the Notifications dated 12.05.1995 and 26.05.1995, has granted uniform compensation @ Rs.12 lakhs per acre for the land falling in Bahadurgarh.

In some cases, mainly RFA No. 2738 of 2005 other land owners had filed review applications of the order passed by this Court in **RFA No. 8 of 2005** titled as **Devinder Singh and others v. State of Haryana and others** and other connected appeals on 31.08.2015, which had been allowed. The said appeals had been allowed on 03.05.2019 in terms of **Rajender Singh's case (supra)**.

The land owners are similarly situated. Accordingly, they are granted benefit of enhanced compensation @ Rs.12 lakhs per acre along with statutory benefits after denying the interest for the delay period i.e. 3090 days.

Disposed of.
