Learned counsel for the petitioner states that other than guardianship certificate, all other documents have already been submitted in respect of the payment to be made to his younger brother, who is 100% disabled. Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that petitioner has already applied for the guardianship certificate.

Learned State counsel very fairly states that in case all the documents including guardianship certificate is submitted by the petitioner, the case for the grant of benefits will be considered by the respondents and appropriate orders will be passed in that regard.

Keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with the observation that in case petitioner submits the guardianship

certificate and other documents as being asked by the respondents, the case of the petitioner for the grant of relief as being claimed in the present writ petition, will be considered by the respondents within a period of three months from the date of receipt of guardianship certificate and appropriate orders in this regard will be passed by the respondents on the claim, which has been made by the petitioner before the respondents.

Writ petition is disposed of in above terms.
