Pursuant to the order dated 24.06.2019, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vipin Kumar, submits that the petitioner has in fact submitted the Will in question to the investigating officer and that the investigation is being continued.

That being so, this petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner would continue to join the investigation as and when summoned and provide documents asked for; and in case he is sought to be arrested, he would be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Illaq Magistrate and abide by all the conditions stipulated in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

If the arresting officer does not join the petitioner in investigation, he would appear before the learned Illaq Magistrate immediately, who would then summon the arresting officer and direct him

to join him in investigation.
