This is the second petition that has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 640 dated 24.10.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

On 12.09.2019, the following order was passed:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per opinion of the doctor, though injury No.1 of Ravi was declared dangerous to life, however, no reasons forming the basis, are given.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners are ready to deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- each, to be paid to the injured/victim Ravi.

List again on 29.10.2019.

In the meantime, petitioners are directed to be released on interim bail subject to furnishing their bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, however, subject to deposit Rs.50,000/- each, to be paid to the

injured/victim Ravi.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance to the order dated 12.09.2019, the petitioners have already deposited the demand draft of Rs. 50,000/- each, to be paid to the injured/victim Ravi. A copy of order dated 13.09.2019, passed by the trial Court, in this regard, has also been placed on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the matter has already been compromised between the parties and a petition bearing CRM-M No. 45956 of 2019 has been filed before this Court praying for quashing of FIR in question on the basis of the said compromise, in which vide order of the even date, notice of motion has been issued for 16.03.2020.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Rohtash, has not disputed the aforesaid facts.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order dated 12.09.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute.
