The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 32 dated 13.02.2019, registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Vide order dated 27.06.2019, the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail noticing the fact that the matter stood compromised between the parties and learned counsel for the complainant/respondent Nos. 2 and 3 had acknowledged that there was a valid compromise between the parties.

Since the Bar is on strike for the last about twelve days and there is no representation on either of the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 27.06.2019, is made absolute subject to the condition that if the petitioner is required for further investigation, he will appear before the Investigating Officer on the notice given by him and the petitioner will also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner is found

misusing the concession of anticipatory bail, it will be open for the prosecution/complainant to apply for recalling of the order.
