Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'Cr. P.C.') for grant of bail to the petitioner, in FIR No.58 dated 01.02.2019, under Sections 120-B, 407 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') (Sections 468, 471, 420 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat.

As per prosecution case, petitioner along with co-accused hatched conspiracy to commit alleged offence by causing wrongful loss to the complainant-company.

Contentends that co-accused of the petitioner, namely Pardeep @ Bittu has already been granted concession of bail pending trial by this Court in CRM-M-23052 of 2019, decided on 24.05.2019 and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by the

learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Sanjeev.

Since the case is triable by the Magistrate and co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted concession of bail pending trial, concededly, the case of the petitioner is on better footings than that of his co-accused and the trial will take long time; thus, his further incarceration will not serve any useful purpose.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, in this case, on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The above observations may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

The petitioner shall fully co-operate with learned trial Court without seeking any unnecessary adjournments.
