Main case

Petitioner-Sukhdev Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C for cancellation of bail granted to respondent Nos.2 to 4 vide order dated 11.06.2019 by Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in case FIR No.208 dated 09.09.2018 registered under Sections 452, 323, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 3 and 4 of Scheduled Castes and Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 added later on) at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the concession of bail was extended to respondent Nos.2 to 4 on 11.06.2019 and on 13.06.2019, he had given a representation to the Commissioner of Police,

Ludhiana regarding the alleged threat extended by the accused to the petitioner. The said ground raised in the representation reads as under:-

“That now the above accused have been bailed out and are openly threatening me that you cannot take any action against us, earlier you left, we shall kill you chammar by running over truck. That in case I suffer any loss to my life or property, the above stated accused will be responsible. I apprehend danger to my life and property at their hands.”

A perusal of the above reveals that the vague allegations have been made which lacks all kinds of particulars as no date, time and manner of threat has been mentioned in the representation.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any reason to exercise the power under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
