The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.798, dated 16.12.2017, under Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 and under Section 379-B IPC (as Section 379-A IPC was deleted), registered at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that petitioner alongwith co-accused has snatched Rs. 20,000/- and a mobile phone from the complainant. He also contends that the recovery of Rs. 20,000/- and a mobile phone have been effected from the co-accused namely, Devender @ Nura and Rohit. It is alleged that the motorcycle on which they were travelling belongs to the petitioner. The petitioner is 21 years of age and is in custody for over 1 year and 8 months

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar states that 8 prosecution witness out of 17 have been

examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 1 year and 8 months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
