Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.56 dated 05.04.2019 under Sections 15, 29 of NDPS Act and Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 27.06.2019: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aged about 71 years and is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act. It is further submitted that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and was named on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused and even subsequent to disclosure, nothing has been recovered from the petitioner...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Paramjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 27.06.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
