This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No. 253 dated 03.07.2017, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376-D, 370, 372 and 373 of the IPC and Section 4 of the POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station Hathin, District Palwal.

After arguing for some time, finding that the Court is not convinced, learned counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer and submits that petitioners may be granted liberty to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court may be directed that if the petitioners move an application for grant of regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.

In view of the above limited prayer of the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in case the petitioners surrender before it within a period of seven days from today and move an application for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of three days thereafter.
