Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.83 dated 19.05.2019 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, offence under Section 307 IPC already deleted and offence under Section 326 IPC added later on, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 04.07.2019, following order was passed:-

“This Court has heard learned counsels for the parties at length and with their able assistance gone through the file.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that both the petitioners are stated to be armed with wooden sticks and no specific injury is attributed. He further submits that a similar situated co-accused, who has same role, has been released on interim bail vide order dated 17.06.2019 passed

in CRM-M-26938-2019. He further submits that the petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the petitioners were members of unlawful assembly and therefore, concession of anticipatory bail should not be extended to them.

Without commenting on merits and keeping in view the role of the petitioners and the contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioners, petitioners are directed to join the investigation.

Adjourned to 29.08.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 04.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
