The averments of the petitioner have already been recorded in order dated 25.06.2019 while issuing notice of motion. Today when the matter is taken up for hearing, learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Davinder Singh, Clerk, office of the Director, Health and Family Welfare, Punjab, submits that the transfer policy/instructions dated 23.04.2017 (Annexure P-2) are applicable in the case of the petitioner, as contended by learned counsel for the petitioner. He further submits that the impugned transfer order is being reconsidered by the competent authority and a decision on the same is likely to be taken in due course and the fresh orders shall be passed thereon.

In the premise the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the court in case any adverse order is passed after fresh consideration of the matter as stated by learned State counsel.

Until the passing of fresh orders the status quo regarding the posting of the petitioner shall be maintained by the State.
