RAMENDRA JAIN, J.

Petitioner Hind Pal has laid challenge to the judgment of the First Appellate Court dated 17.5.2017, affirming the judgment of conviction and order of sentence of the learned trial Court dated 27.10.2014, whereby he was held guilty under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for two years and to pay a fine of Rs.2000/-. In default thereof, he shall further undergo imprisonment for 3 months.

Through application filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, prayer has been made by the petitioner for condonation of delay of 432 days in filing the instant petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there was no one in the family to pursue the litigation on behalf of the petitioner. Therefore, delay of 432 days occurred in filing the instant revision.

Custody certificate of the petitioner filed today in the connected

petition shows that the petitioner has already completed the sentence of two years.

Therefore, the present petition has become infructuous and is dismissed.
