HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for seeking direction to official respondent No.2 & 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent No.4.

It has been averred that date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 15.04.1998 and petitioner No.2 is 27.12.1992 and copies of Aadhar Cards of petitioners No.1 & 2 to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 & P-2 respectively.

It has been submitted that marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 22.06.2019 as per Sikh Rites and ceremonies Sri Nirankari Darbar (Rawalpindi), Sector-21B, Chandigarh. The Marriage certificate and photographs of marriage are attached as Annexures P-3 & P-4 respectively. Private respondent No.4 is opposed to the marriage, as the

petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 24.06.2019 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondent.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Lata Singh vs. State of U.P. And another, 2006 (2) SCC (Criminal) 478*, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
