HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 & 5.

The marriage of petitioner No.1 was solemnized with respondent No.4 on 07.12.2008 and one child namely Tejaswi was born out of the wedlock on 02.04.2010. It is alleged that husband of petitioner No.1 (respondent No.4) and his other family members used to beat petitioner No.1 and maltreat her. They made her life hell. On account of which, she had no option to leave the matrimonial home in the second week of May 2019. Petitioner No.1 even contemplated suicide however due to intervention of petitioner No.2, she was saved. Thereafter, petitioner No.1 has been residing with petitioner No.2. Parents of petitioner No.2 had also

accepted petitioner No.1 and they are presently living in live-in relationship. It is stated that petitioner No.2 is also married, however, his wife has left him about two years back. The petitioners apprehended danger particularly from respondents No.4 & 5. In this regard, the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) to respondent no.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
