HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 9.

It has been averred that date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 10.10.1997 and petitioner No.2 is 20.03.2000 and copy of Aadhar Card of petitioner No.1 and copy of PAN Card of petitioner No.2 to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 & P-2 respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were in love with each other since two years and when private respondents No.4 to 9 came to know their relations, they got agitated. The petitioners asked the private respondents to allow them to live in a live-in relationship, but they got negative response. Thereafter, petitioner No.1 left her house on

22.06.2019 and started to live with petitioner No.2 in a live-in relationship.

The petitioners apprehend danger from private respondents no.4 to 9. In this regard, the petitioners have submitted a representation dated 22.06.2019 (Annexure P-4) to respondent no.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
