1. By way of filing this petition, petitioner-Vipin seeks grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.135, dated 1.6.2019, registered at Police Station Loharu, District Bhiwani, under Sections 323, 341, 427, 506, 34 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is real brother of the complainant and that the FIR came to be lodged due to some misunderstandings amongst the brothers which has now been resolved and they have compromised the matter and that in fact a petition seeking for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise has also been filed in this Court.

3. The learned State counsel has filed reply of Gajender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Loharu, District Bhiwani, Haryana which is taken on record. It has been submitted that since the petitioner is involved in a large number of other cases, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out. It has however, been informed that the petitioner has joined investigation
4. I have considered rival submissions addressed before this court. Bearing in mind the fact that complainant and the petitioner are real brothers and have compromised the matter and that the petitioner has since joined investigation, in my opinion, it is not a case warranting custodial interrogation. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued vide order dated 25.6.2019 are made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear and join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
5. The present petition stands accepted accordingly.
