Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.73 dated 04.05.2019 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on vide diary No.42 dated 27.05.2019), registered at Police Station Cantonment Amritsar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 28.06.2019: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners, inter alia, contends that prior to registration of the present FIR, one DDR bearing No.41 was registered against the complainant's party, in which, one person from the petitioners' side, namely Samir Singh, was injured and aforesaid DDR was registered against the complainant of the

present FIR, namely Danishpreet Singh....”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Pal, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 28.06.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
