The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.564 dated 20.09.2017 under Sections 279, 337, 379A IPC (Sections 392 & 394 IPC were added and Sections 279, 337 & 379A IPC were deleted later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

The operative part of the order dated 01.07.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on 20.09.2017 against five unknown persons and thereafter, Sonu and Sandeep @ Deepu were arrested and in their disclosure statements, the name of the petitioner surfaced and at initial stage, the petitioner had joined investigation and he was not arrested.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment dated 26.10.2018 (Annexure P-2), vide which, aforesaid two co-accused Sonu and Sandeep @ Deepu, who faced full length trial, have been acquitted by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI

Iqbal Singh, could not dispute the factual position.

Adjourned to 30.07.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 01.07.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sita Ram, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 01.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
