HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Cr. P. C., 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 84 dated 21.03.2019 registered under Sections 308, 452, 323, 427, 148, 149 and 506 of IPC, at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur.

On 11.09.2019, this Court passed the following order :-

“Adjourned to 08.11.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when

called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 11.09.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Nanak Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
