[1] Separate replies have been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 2, 4 & 5 in Court today, while contesting respondent No.3 has not filed reply but states that respondent No.3 is ready to redress the grievance of the petitioners by granting admission to the petitioners in Class 12 (Medical Stream) and Class 10 (General Stream) respectively, in case, the petitioners complete the requisite formalities. The same satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioners.

[2] In view thereof, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** by directing the petitioners to complete the formalities as may be required by respondent No.3 by going to the office of respondent No.3 within next three working days.

[3] Issuance of School Leaving Certificate by respondent No.3 would have no effect in view of the statement of learned counsel for respondent No.3 and the petitioners shall be allowed re-admission, subject to completion of formalities.
