Petitioners approached this Court seeking directions to the official respondents to take necessary steps for protection of their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 6.

It was contended that the petitioners have got married against the wishes of the elders and it is under such circumstances that they fear for their life.

Upon notice of motion having been issued, learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Aman, Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar, apprises the Court that the statements of private respondents no.4 and 5, who happen to be the parents of petitioner no.1 Harpreet Kaur have been recorded and as per which they are not opposed to the matrimonial alliance entered into.

Even counsel representing the petitioners would submit that they do not now apprehend any threat to their life and liberty.

Under such circumstances, no directions are required to be passed in the instant petition.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
