As per pleadings on record, son of petitioners no.1 and 2 has entered into a matrimonial alliance with the daughter of respondents no.4 and 5. It is stated to be an inter caste marriage which is not acceptable to the private respondents.

An apprehension is voiced in the instant petition that the private respondents are repeatedly threatening the petitioners of dire consequences.

In the light of the short grievance raised in the petition and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent no.3 as regards their threat perception. In the eventuality of any such application being filed, respondent no.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
