Prayer in this application is for addition of offences under Sections 465, 468 and 471 of the IPC in the head note as well as in the prayer clause of the main petition.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed.

The Registry is directed to make the necessary corrections in the head note as well as in the prayer clause of the main petition.

The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 51 dated 01.03.2019, under Sections 420, 120-B of the IPC (Sections 465, 468, 471 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

The operative part of the order dated 01.07.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned State counsel, on instruction from ASI Swaran Singh, has informed the Court that a Special Investigating Team has been constituted and the investigation is pending with Additional Director General of Police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will deposit an amount of Rs.60,000/- with the Illaqua Magistrate within a period of 15 days from today, subject to final outcome of the investigation/trial.

Notice of motion for 9.8.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 01.07.2019, has joined the investigation and has deposited the amount of Rs. 60,000/- with the Illaqua Magistrate. A photocopy of the receipt, in this regard, is also placed on record.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and while confirming the interim bail granted on 01.07.2019, the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail under the newly added sections i.e. Sections 465, 468 and 471 of the IPC as well, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
