Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.47 dated 10.05.2019 under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Pursuant to the order dated 3.10.2019, Harsh Kumar, petitioner in CRM-M-32208 of 2019 is present in the Court.

Counsel for the petitioners on instructions received from the petitioners, states that they are ready to settle the matter.

The petitioners being the parents in law of the complainant and the fact that the main allegation are demand of motorcycle and cash are against the petitioner in connected petition bearing CRM-M-32208-2019 which has been referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 01.07.2019 is made absolute.

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However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
