Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.12
dated 18.01.2019 under Sections 307, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station
Sector-14, Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that
the matter has been settled between the parties, including victim Vikas and the
petitioner is in custody since 22.01.2019. It is further submitted that even one of
the eye-witness, who appeared before the trial Court, was also declared hostile

by the Public Prosecutor in view of the compromise.

Victim Vikas is present in the Court and he is identified by the Investigating Officer ASI Jitender Singh. On asking of the Court, the Investigating Officer has verified from the victim that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 22.01.2019; the matter has been compromised between the parties and the prosecution witness/eye-witness have already been declared hostile, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
