The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.30 dated 07.03.2019, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B, 376 IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

It has been submitted that as per the FIR, one Bitra alias Happy had kidnapped the prosecutrix. When the prosecutrix recovered, she suffered statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. wherein she has stated that the mother (petitioner herein) of said Bitra alias Happy had arranged a room for them.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody for the last about three months. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and

keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Manjeet Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of her absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel her bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure her presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) She shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
