The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.119 dated 02.09.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the name of the petitioner has been wrongly involved in this case. Even, as per the case of the prosecution, the injury attributed to the petitioner is only simple in nature. The injury inviting Section 326 IPC is not attributable to the petitioner. It is further contended that the petitioner is in custody since April, 2019. There is no other case against the petitioner. It is further contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted bail by the Trial Court. Petitioner is not required for any investigation purposes.

On the other hand, learned State counsel being instructed by ASI Rajinder Singh, submits that participation of the petitioner in the crime is substantiated by the fact that the injury attributed to the petitioner is corroborated by the medical evidence. However, it is not disputed that the injury attributed to the petitioner is only simple in nature. It is also not disputed that there is no other case against the petitioner.

In view the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to her furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
