This is the second attempt made by the petitioner to seek directions to safeguard his life and liberty. The earlier petition was dismissed on 19.6.2019 by passing the following order :-

“Having argued the matter at some length, counsel prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to avail of the other alternate remedies as may be available to the petitioner in according with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prays for.”

Even otherwise, a perusal of the representation dated 10.6.2019 (Annexure P-1) and representation dated 20.6.2019 (Annexure P-3), addressed to the Station House Officer, Police Station Gur Harsahai and the Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur, respectively, shows that it is alleged that on 9.6.2019, the petitioner was doing irrigation work in his agricultural land and the private respondents came there with an intention to kill him and they were likely to cause harm to the life and property of the petitioner.

Neither any copy of the jamabandi attached to show ownership in possession over the land nor any person is cited as a witness in support of allegations.

Since the petitioner has already withdrawn his first petition to avail the alternative remedy, however, instead of filing a complaint before the competent Court of law, the petitioner has again filed this petition.

In view of the same, the present petition stands dismissed.
