1. Learned State counsel has today filed status report by way of affidavit of Narender Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hisar.

The same is taken on record. Copy whereof has been supplied to the learned counsel opposite.

2. As per status report, the matter has been inquired into by DSP, Hisar and that during the course of investigation the allegations were not found to be substantiated and a cancellation report had been prepared by the police.
3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and having perused the record of the case and while refraining from making any expression as regards the allegations leveled in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Hisar (respondent No.2) to get the matter examined in respect of FIR No.214, dated 28.5.2019, registered at Police Station Azad Nagar, Hisar, under Sections 452, 376(2)(N), 376(2)(F) 506, 354(A), 34 IPC and Section 9(P) and 10 of POCSO Act as well as FIR No. 362, dtd 28.6.2019, registered at Police Station Hisar Sadar, District Hisar, under Sections 323, 34, 341, 506 IPC from an officer, senior to DSP who had earlier inquired into the matter who shall consider any such representation as may be submitted by the petitioner/complainant within 2 weeks from today, before a final report in respect of the aforesaid two FIRs is filed.
4. A copy of this order be sent to Superintendent of Police, Hisar (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
5. The petition stands disposed off as indicated above.

In view of the order passed above in the main case, these two applications are rendered redundant and are dismissed as such.
