ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 52, dated 23.05.2019, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he is attesting witness for an agreement to sell entered between Lachman Singh and co-accused Ranjit Singh on 14.05.1999. He also contends that the agreement to sell did not fructify and the complainant is still in possession of the land. The petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 28.05.2019. He is 62 years of age and is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
